RECOMMENDATION:

Receive a report on Department of Toxic Substances Control ("DTSC") Land Use Covenants ("LUC") annual reporting for FY 17-18.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

On September 14, 2007, the FORA Board approved a Memorandum of Agreement ("MOA") among DTSC, California State University Monterey Bay ("CSUMB"), University of California Monterey Bay Education, Science, and Technology Center ("UC MBEST"), Monterey Peninsula College ("MPC"), County of Monterey, the Cities of Seaside, Marina, Del Rey Oaks, and Monterey ("eight reporting entities"). The agreement specified that FORA would compile former Fort Ord annual LUC reports from each of the eight reporting entities and forward them to DTSC on an annual basis. In the MOA, the County agreed to assume FORA's LUC annual reporting role when FORA ceases to exist. According to the MOA, FORA would also reimburse DTSC's oversight costs (originally estimated to be \$20,000 annually) for the first two years (FY 07-08 and FY 08-09) of annual reporting through funds designated for this purpose and, after the first two years, FORA would reimburse DTSC for its oversight costs through dues collected from the eight reporting entities and FORA would collect an additional 15% administrative cost from the eight reporting entities in order to reimburse FORA staff time associated with the activity of collecting and compiling annual reports, submitting reports to DTSC, and reimbursing DTSC for its oversight costs.

For FY 17-18, FORA has collected LUC reports from the eight reporting entities (<u>Attachment A</u>) and submitted them to DTSC on November 30, 2018.

Reviewed by FORA Controller
The fiscal impact is cost neutral. As described in the MOA, beginning in FY 09-10, FORA collected the
costs associated with LUC reporting from the eight reporting entities at the same time FORA collected its
annual membership dues.
