Objectives Tracked Changes



- Provide a primary southwest-northeast corridor through former Fort Ord, while maintaining an acceptable level of service throughout the FORA CIP and regional roadway network with the implementation of the approved reuse of Fort Ord
- De-emphasize Inter-Garrison Road as a major vehicular route with greater emphasis placed on pedestrian and bicycle traffic
 Recognize Intergarrison Road as a vehicular route while providing the greater accommodation of pedestrian and bicycle traffic
- UtilizeFully evaluate the utilization of existing roadways as the foundation for the future network
