About the Meeting

In March 2007, FORA and the U.S. Army entered into an agreement for removal of remnant Munitions and Explosives of Concern (MEC) from approximately 3,340 acres of land at the former Fort Ord. Under this agreement, called an Environmental Services Cooperative Agreement (ESCA), the Army provides dedicated grant funding to FORA for removal of MEC.

Once the remediation activities are completed, the properties will be transferred to local jurisdictions for future use and development according to the Reuse Plan for the former Fort Ord area.

You are invited to come to the meeting to learn more about how this work will be done and meet and talk with expert staff who will be carrying out this work. We look forward to meeting with you, hearing your questions and concerns, and working together on this important project.

Directions to FORA Conference Facility

From Marina and North:

Take Hwy. 1 South to the 12th Street Exit (Imjin Parkway). At the top of the exit ramp turn left onto Imjin Parkway. Turn left at the first light (2nd Avenue). Proceed to the end of the road and turn left. FORA Conference Facility will be on the right.

From Monterey and South:

Take Hwy. 1 North to the 12th Street Exit. The exit ramp will ease you onto Imjin Parkway. Turn left at the first light (2nd Avenue). FORA Conference Facility will be on the right.
