### **Notice of Detour: Broadway Avenue at General Jim Moore Blvd.**

Beginning 7AM on Thursday September 2, 2010 a traffic detour will be in place on Broadway Avenue at General Jim Moore Boulevard in the City of Seaside. Both east bound lanes on Broadway Avenue will be closed and east bound traffic will be moved onto one of the west bound lanes of Broadway at Mescal Street.

From Broadway Avenue: Traffic will be detoured onto General Jim Moore Boulevard to Coe Avenue where it will then be detoured onto the new General Jim Moore Boulevard. Traffic can then head north or south on the easterly lanes of new General Jim Moore Boulevard.

From South Boundary Road: Traffic will be detoured onto the easterly lanes of the new General Jim Moore Boulevard.

From General Jim Moore Boulevard to Broadway: Traffic will exit from new General Jim Moore Boulevard near Coe Avenue onto old General Jim Moore Boulevard. Traffic can then turn onto old General Jim Moore Boulevard to Broadway Avenue.

Old General Jim Moore Boulevard south of Broadway Avenue and north of the connection to new General Jim Moore Boulevard will be closed to all traffic during the time of the detour. The westerly lanes of new General Jim Moore Boulevard will also be closed to all traffic while the detour is in place.

The detour will remain in operation for approximately one month at which time Broadway Avenue will be opened to the easterly lanes of new General Jim Moore Boulevard.

If possible, alternate routes should be used to reduce traffic loads on the detour for those who have no alternate routes available.

Signs and flagmen will be in place to assist drivers in negotiating the detour. Patience and tolerance is requested with this temporary inconvenience. Please be observant of construction work taking place close to the roadway and watch for flagmen. Please expect delays.
