Simple Scope Explanation:

- Create Maps and compile background data
- Prepare utility installation and maintenance guidelines for jurisdictions
- Prepare Construction Support Plans Needed for DTSC, ARMY, and EPA Permits on FORA CIP Projects:
 - Eucalyptus & GJMB Infiltrator Repair (Munitions Response Area 1-4)
 - South Boundary Road Corridor
- Provide Estimates for on-call Construction Support and After-Action Reporting.

Recommendation



Two Service Work Orders – Not to Exceed:

SWO-E1 - Seaside MRA 1-4 \$32,940

SWO-E2 - South Boundary Road Corridor \$40,860

Staff Recommends:

Authorize Executive Officer to execute Work Authorization AUS-FORA-2018-051118 to the Environmental Services Cooperative Agreement Remedial Services Agreement, Contract Change Order #5, Master Services Agreement with ARCADIS US, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$73,800 to provide supplemental Unexploded Ordnance Construction Support for the FORA CIP.
