


FORA Munitions Removal Grant Contract Overview

- Administrative Order on Consent (AOC)
- Remedial Services Agreement (RSA)



ESCA Documents / Operational Relationships





Environmental Services Cooperative Agreement (ESCA)

- Executed in 2007 – runs 30 years to 2037
- Defines responsibilities for Annual and Five-Year Review, Reports, etc.
- Assigns FORA responsibilities to implement ESCA in Technical Specifications Requirements Statement (TSRS)
- Contract between U.S. Army and FORA – Army to Review Successor



Administrative Order on Consent (AOC)

- Executed in 2007 – runs through life of FORA, multi-party
- Defines responsibilities for remediation on the ESCA property, reports, etc. as noted in TSRS
- Contract between U.S. Army, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and CA Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) - EPA/DTSC to Approve FORA Successor



Remedial Services Agreement (RSA)

- Executed in 2007 – runs through life of AIG coverage
- Defines ARCADIS (FORA contractor) responsibilities for munitions removal and documents processing on the ACES, reports, etc. as noted in TSRS
- Contract between FORA and ARCADIS
- Ends upon Regulatory Site Closure



Variables

- Land Use Implementation Plan – Operations and Maintenance Plan (LUCIP-OMP)
- Stewardship / Long-term Obligation (Still to be determined)
